# Competition rules:

Teams of 2 members each are allowed to register. Single members can register as well. Several teams from the same company can be formed.

Both ISTC preliminaries and finals will be 3-hours duration events. The preliminaries round will be held online supported by YouTube Live Streaming to allow the participants to watch the SUT presentation and ask questions in live chat. ISTC Finals will be done onsite on **June 24, 2019 17:00-20:00** during **QAGeekWeek** conference as one of its highlights.

The SUT (Software Under Test) will be announced only at the beginning of the challenge. A representative from the SUT company will be present throughout the competition round (online for the preliminaries) to answer questions about the product and to outline the priorities for testing.

The participants will come up with a strategy and approach to test the SUT, execute the tests and report bugs using **Inflectra SpiraTest**. An additional deliverable will be the final test report informing the SUT owners about the product status, major issues, release recommendations and suggested fixes aligned to the priorities set by the SUT representative. Participants might also add details about their testing strategy.

## Judging Criteria

- Reporting the right kind of bugs, bugs the product team care about.
- The quality of bug reports - understandable and reproducible.
- The quality and accuracy of test report - is the information correct?
- Non-functional testing, should teams decide to do so.
- Bonus points for interacting with judges and the "customer".
